## **INFORMATION**

FOR: MURDER IN THE SECOND DEGREE ~ 21 O.S. § 701.8, a FELONY

## STATE OF OKLAHOMA, COUNTY OF CARTER:

I, Craig Ladd, the undersigned District Attorney of said County, in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, give information that in said County of Carter and in the State of Oklahoma, JOSHUA TAYLOR, mutually and conjointly with Brandon Dingman, did then and there unlawfully, willfully, knowingly and wrongfully commit the crime of:

MURDER IN THE SECOND DEGREE ~ a FELONY, around midnight on the 4th day of July, 2019, by committing the felony crime of Assault and Battery With a Dangerous Weapon on Jared Lakey, in violation of 21 O.S. §645, and such felonious conduct constituted a substantial factor in the subsequent death of Jared Lakey, to-wit: Defendant Joshua Taylor, together with Brandon Dingman, did then and there assault and batter Jared Lakey with their X26P CEWs (conducted energy weapons), also commonly known as "tasers", by tasing Lakey for a combined total of more than fifty (50) times which greatly exceeded what would have been necessary or warranted by the attendant circumstances, with such dangerous and unnecessary tasing constituting a substantial factor in bringing about the death of Jared Lakey on July 6, 2019, without any premeditated design to effect the death of any particular individual, contrary to the form of the statute in such cases made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment for 10 years to life.
