Take your time. Answer all the questions to the best of your ability. **DO NOT ASK FOR HELP.** There are no right or wrong answers. The only requirement is that the answers be full and honest.

We need your candid answers so that we can pick a fair and impartial jury for a trial involving criminal accusations. The judge and the lawyers realize that every person has beliefs and opinions concerning many things. You should answer with your true feelings, whatever they may be. Do not assume that any of your answers will qualify you or disqualify you from serving on this jury.

If you cannot answer a question because you do not understand it, write "Do not understand" in the space after the question. If you cannot answer because you do not know, write "Do not know" in the space after the question. Write only on the front side of each page. If you need additional space for an answer, there are blank pages at the end of the questionnaire for that purpose. Write "see back page" on your answer. On the back page(s), be sure to include the question number to which you are responding.

Under Ohio Law, your answers will usually be subject to public disclosure, but personal identifying information is generally not subject to disclosure.

Your full cooperation is of the utmost importance to the administration of justice in this case. You will be asked in court, under oath, if you have answered all the questions fully and honestly. I know you will take your potential jury service seriously, and I thank you for your time serving your community.
