Detective Hurley advised your affiant that she responded to the above residence and she learned that _____ was last seen around 1100 hours by the complainant, _____, as he left for a medical appointment. _____ told Detective Hurley that he was expecting _____ to go to a nail appointment scheduled for 1400 hours with _____ Crystal Williams. _____ returned home around 1330 hours and saw that _____ Crystal Williams was home but did not see _____ Crystal told _____ hat _____ had sent her home to change her clothing, because she looked like a bum. Crystal changed her clothing and left the residence. _____ has not seen Crystal since.

_____ told Detective Hurley that he had received a call from a subject, around 2000 hours, who stated that he had found a cell phone in the area of 27th Ave. and Aviation Blvd. The call came from _____ cell phone. _____ met with the subject and recovered the cell phone. It was after this suspicious incident and the fact that _____ had not been seen since 1100 hours that prompted the family to call the Sheriff's Office and file the missing person report.

_____ told Detective Hurley that it was suspicious that Crystal was driving _____ van, as _____ is the only one to drive it. _____ assumed that when Crystal left their residence that _____ was at the nail salon. _____ signed a stolen vehicle affidavit in reference to the van as he is the registered owner. A bolo was issued for the complainant's 2018 Chrysler van.

Your affiant responded to the Sheriff's Office Detective Bureau at approximately 2330 hours on March 9, 2020, to assist in the investigation. Your affiant spoke with _____ an _____ of Crystal William's. _____ told your affiant that Crystal had arrived at his residence earlier today, around 1630 hours, unannounced. _____ stated that Crystal seemed distraught. He asked her what was wrong and she told him the less he knew the better. _____ did learn that Crystal had been involved in an argument with _____ but he claimed he did not know any details, but he did know that Crystal was being kicked out of the residence at _____. _____ advised that he and Crystal had visited Walmart on March 9th and that he gave her \$120 cash. In conversation with Crystal, _____ learned that she was planning to leave town via Greyhound Bus, possibly to Tennessee.

Detective Hurley advised your affiant that _____ gave her consent to search his cellular telephone, which included text messages between him and Crystal. The following text message was sent from Crystal to _____ on March 10, 2020, at 12:25 AM and was observed by Detective Hurley.

_____ provided information which led your affiant to believe Crystal was staying on a boat owned by _____ that was currently docked at the Fort Pierce Marina. Information was relayed to Fort Pierce Police Department and they later located _____ stolen vehicle in a parking garage in close proximity to the marina.

Your affiant, Detective Hurley and members of the Indian River County Sheriff's Office located Crystal Williams at the Marina. She was asked if she was aware of _____ disappearance. She replied that she was aware _____ was missing and stated she had been in contact recently with _____ about it. Crystal was asked if she would willingly return to Indian River County to assist with the investigation. She willingly agreed to be transported to the Sheriff's Office to aid in the investigation.

Your affiant advised Crystal of her Rights. She stated that she understood her Rights and agreed to answer questions. Crystal told your affiant that she and _____ had went to a nail appointment the previous day around 1100 hours. She claimed that she had returned home around 1230 to change clothes and later visited a friend on _____ in Vero Beach. She claimed that _____ later drove her to the Fort Pierce Marina to visit _____ around 1400 hours and that she stayed at the Marina until the time that she returned to Indian River County with your affiant.

I confronted Crystal with the fact that I knew she was in Vero Beach around 1700 hours at a local Walmart. Crystal became upset and requested an attorney. The interview was terminated. Crystal Williams was charged with Grand Theft Auto and transported to the County Jail.

At approximately 0830 hours on March 10, 2020, while briefing fellow Detectives on the case, your affiant was in the process of having Detective Sunkel contact a cadaver dog handler for the purpose of searching the _____ and the residence at _____ when I was advised that Corrections Officer D. Dorsett had contacted the Detective Bureau and advised that Crystal Williams had told her that she knew wished to speak with Detectives to advise where _____ was.

She told your affiant that she was helping _____ move boxes _____ when _____ made a comment that sent Crystal into a rage. Crystal stated that _____ was screaming during the fight, and estimated it lasted for a few minutes. Crystal showed your affiant an injury to her left wrist/hand that she sustained during the fight. She did not provide details on exactly how _____ was killed. She did state that she _____ so that nobody would find her.

After speaking to Williams, Sgt. Shepherd informed your affiant that _____ had been found deceased inside _____ at _____ by Sgt. Curley and Detective Sunkel, who responded to the residence based on the information provided by Williams.

Sgt. Shepherd advised your affiant that the victim was found _____
