Defendant's Waiver of Post-Conviction Rights

COMES NOW the Defendant in the above-styled case, in connection with the resolution of this case, and in consideration of the State's agreement to dismiss Count 1, Felony Murder based on Elder Neglect, Defendant hereby waives his right to file a motion for new trial, to seek habeas relief, and to appeal from the judgment of conviction and sentence entered as to Count 3 of the Indictment, Elder Neglect. Defendant accepts the verdict of the jury and the sentence imposed by the Court and waives all rights to post-conviction relief.

Defendant hereby certifies that he has been advised by his trial counsel, Aaron Henrickson, of his right to file a motion for new trial, his right to seek habeas corpus relief, and his right to appeal from the judgment of conviction and sentence in this case. Defendant certifies that he has been advised of all rights he is waiving hereby. Defendant has been advised of the consequences of this waiver.


Defendant is satisfied with trial counsel's representation.

In exchange, the State agrees to dismiss Count 1 of the indictment, Felony Murder based upon Elder Neglect.


